CONCLUSIONS

#1 🔪

- LASAT can be applied to CMC/EBC systems involving SiC/SiC -Si-Yb₂Si₂O₇
- HV-APS 25x25 mm² sample exhibited a conventional behaviour upon LASAT \rightarrow LAST 2D curves can be envisaged

With protective tape + water

- IR imaging can be advantageously envisaged for a non destructive assessment of the interfacial damage
- MS or CS modes can be envisaged, the use of a protective layer is preferred
- The weakest and lowest toughness interfacial zone seems to be located within the Si layer after deposition
- The presence of large pores within CMC may have attenuated the propagating shockwave in case of the APS sample
